Movies with Coming Out Issues Involving Parents and Children

Bridegroom

The tragic results of homophobia is explored in this award-winning documentary from writer/producer/director Linda Bloodworth Thomason.

Philomena

A world-weary political journalist picks up the story of a woman's search for her son, who was taken away from her decades ago after she became pregnant and was forced to live in a convent.

Flawless

Rusty (<u>Philip Seymour Hoffman</u>) is one of Walter's drag queen neighbors and the two are at-odds constantly due to their differing lifestyles. Rusty has a desire to undergo a <u>transsexual</u> operation, but lacks the money to do so.

Dallas Buyer's Club (December 2013)

A son of Texas, Ron Woodroof is an electrician and rodeo cowboy. In 1985, he is well into an unexamined existence with a devil-may-care lifestyle. Suddenly, Ron is blindsided by being diagnosed as H.I.V.-positive and given 30 days to live. Yet he will not, and does not, accept a death sentence. His crash course of research reveals a lack of approved treatments and medications in the U.S., so Ron crosses the border into Mexico. There, he learns about alternative treatments and begins smuggling them into the U.S., challenging the medical and scientific community including his concerned physician, Dr. Eve Saks. An outsider to the gay community, Ron finds an unlikely ally in fellow AIDS patient Rayon, a transsexual who shares Ron's lust for life. Rayon also shares Ron's entrepreneurial spirit: seeking to avoid government sanctions against selling non-approved medicines and supplements, they establish a "buyers club," where H.I.V.-positive people pay monthly dues for access to the newly acquired supplies. Deep in the heart of Texas, Ron's pioneering underground collective beats loud and strong. With a growing community of friends and clients, Ron fights for dignity, education, and acceptance. In the years following his diagnosis, the embattled Lone Star loner lives life to the fullest like never before. « less

The Wise Kids

A vivid, dynamic Southern coming-of-age drama, takes place in the transitional space between high school and college, when life seems to be all questions and no answers, and the future is scarily wide open. Set in and around a Charleston, SC Baptist church, weaving through this ensemble piece are three main characters - Brea, an introspective pastor's daughter experiencing debilitating doubt, the hyperactive Laura, Brea's best friend and a devout believer, and Tim, the open-hearted son of a single father, confronting his homosexuality for the first time. Tensions and buried feelings abound, as colleges are chosen and adults behave badly, as Brea, Laura and Tim attempt to hang onto what they have, all the while yearning to break free. C.R.A.Z.Y.

French Canadian (subtitles). A subtle portrayal of the coming out of a teenage boy who tries to live up to his mach father's expectations while navigating his way among four brothers.

BEAUTIFUL THING

Set in working class England, two teenage neighbors discover their attraction to each other. Together they begin to explore the wider gay world. Mom is not happy at first but comes around.

GET REAL

Two middle/upper middle class English high school boys become boyfriends. One works on the school newspaper and the other is the school jock. Jock wants to stay safely in the closet and his boyfriend does not.

TORCH SONG TRIOLOGY

Although made in 1988 as an adaptation of Harvey Fierstein's award winning play, this film is still relevant. It exposes and explores the damage done by homophobia and futile attempts to go straight.

It is an intimate portrayal of a family in crisis and a mother who believes that her daughter is going to blaze a brave new path if she can just keep her sober long enough to grow up. PRIDE

Based on a true story, the film depicts a group of <u>lesbian</u> and <u>gay</u> activists who raised money to help families affected by the <u>British miners' strike</u> in 1984, at the outset of what would become the <u>Lesbians and Gays Support the Miners</u> campaign. The <u>National Union of Mineworkers</u> was reluctant to accept the group's support due to the union's public relations' worries about being openly associated with a gay group, so the activists instead decided to take their donations directly to <u>Onllwyn</u>, a small mining village in <u>Wales</u>, resulting in an alliance between the two communities. The alliance was unlike any seen before but was successful.
